This year we have conducted 5 different programmes through our organization.

Children Education programme : Under this programme we have conducted 5 children centers in Thotlapalem, Jupudi, Tufan Nagar, Pedapalikaluru and Mangalagiri villages. We have provided tutoring, milk and egg to these children everyday. There are 125 children were joined in all the centers. Children get good marks in their examinations. All the parents felt very happy about this programme.



Drinking water pump : we have laid total 7 drinking water pumps in Schedule caste and Tribal areas in Guntur and Manyam district of Andhrapradesh state. There are 1000 people are benefitting through this programme. Before the laid these pumps they are bringing water from small ponds. This water is not safe. Because it is a polluted water. Some people travel 2 km to bring water. Now they are safety ground water. We have laid these pumps in Sandhiguda (Tribal area) Bandanamguda (Tribal area) Kagumanuguda (Tribal area) Kurupam (Tribal area),Bheemaram (Back ward class) ,Podapadu (Schedule caste) Pedaprolu (schedule caste)





Skill training for women : we have conducted skill training for women on Jute bag making & tailoring in Mangalagiri and paladugu. There are 30 women get training on Jute bag making in Mangalagiri. All these women belongs to schedule caste. Now a days people are using jute bags for all purposes. So this course is very useful to them. In Paladugu village we have conducted training on Tailoring. There are 25 women get training in this village. All these women belongs to Tribal community. Some women are working in tailoring shops and some are working as tailors with their own. They earing money for their family needs. We gave certificates to all these women.





Awareness on Sexual Reproductive Health : We have conducted awareness programme for women and adolescents on Sexual reproductive health programme. The main objectives of increasing awareness for reproductive health are: It helps in educating every youth about sexual and reproductive health. It creates awareness among adolescents about safe sexual practices. It helps in preventing sexually transmitted infections, including HIV/AIDS.



Support to Leprosy Effected : we gave support leprosy effected persons through giving medicines. There are 40 leprosy effected people are living in Bunny nagar colony near Guntur. They are not able to do any work for their daily needs. So we have distributed medicines to that persons along with financial support
